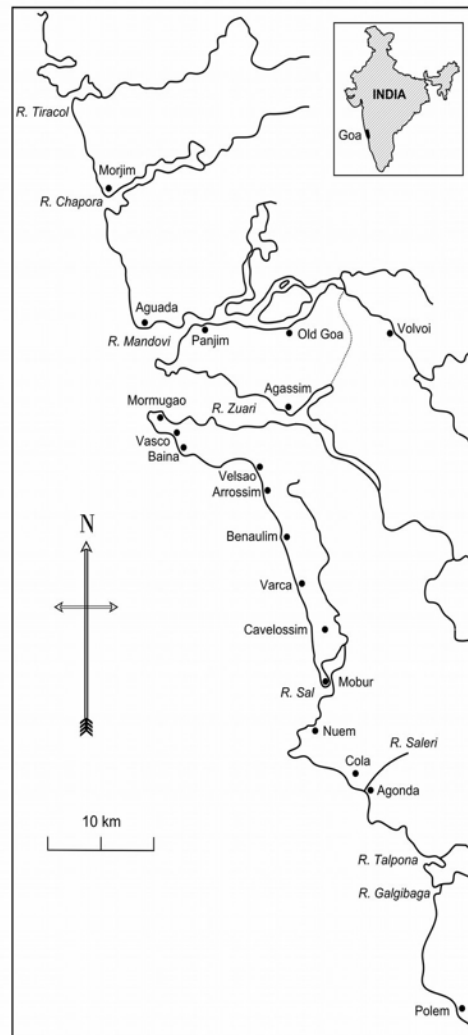


Figure 1. Map of the small state of Goa. The confluence of its two largest rivers provides an anchorage downstream of Panjim for seagoing ships (C. Farmer).

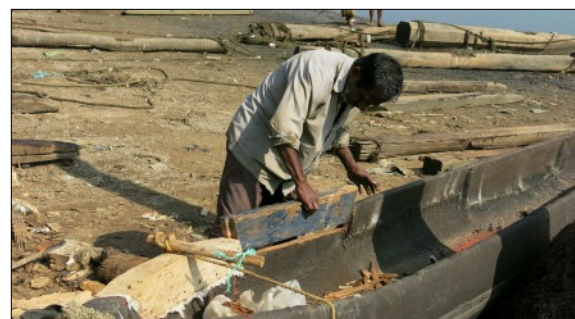


Figure 2. Monoxyllous craft used on Goa's rivers. They are so heavily coated in dikh that sewn portions are difficult to detect: a) upturned with booms still attached. Assolna; b) under repair on the slip at Cavelossim. Author.
